**A14 Cambridgeshire: Repairs to Surface and Roadmarkings on Slip Roads**

On behalf of the Highways Agency I am writing to inform you of slip road improvement works starting shortly on the A14 slip roads, between junction 29 (Bar Hill) and junction 30 (Dry Drayton).

The overnight works are programmed to commence on the evening of Monday 6 February 2012 and are expected to be completed by early March. Works will involve repairs to the slip road surface and renewal the road markings on both the entry and exit slip roads.

The working hours are:

9:00pm to 6:00am	Monday and Thursday nights
10:00pm to 6:00am	Friday nights

During the road works it will be necessary to implement slip road closures. The diversion route for exit slip road closures will be to continue to the next junction and return to exit from the opposite direction. For entry slip road closures the diversion will be to travel in the opposite direction to the next junction and return to the main carriageway. All diversion routes will be clearly signed. Only one slip road will be closed at any given time.

There will inevitably be some noise generated by the works and any noisy operations that need to be undertaken will be completed as early as possible each evening. We apologise for any inconvenience these works may cause.
